And while we know TQ youth face many of the same pressures and prejudices that put LGB lives at risk, there's still almost no tobacco-related health information for TQ youth on the books. Why does FACT stand with LGBTQ teens? Because Wisconsin LGB teens are twice as likely to smoke a cigarette before they're 13.



Nicotine doesn't fight fair. Lesbian and bisexual girls are 9.7 times more likely to pick up a weekly cigarette addiction than heterosexual girls.
